

Flagger Safety

Effective traffic control is essential to protecting workers and the general public. Flaggers are in a very dangerous, yet extremely responsible position and play a critical role in Temporary Traffic Control. The safety of workers, motorists and pedestrians is dependent upon the flaggers' performance. The instructor for this course has completed the National Safety Council's Flagging Instructor Certification program.

The course is designed for construction work zone flaggers new to the job or needing a refresher. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive a certificate of completion. OSHA does not have any refresher requirements. National Safety Council requires refresher every 3 years.

Our training incorporates requirements set forth in the MUTCD and OSHA 29 CFR 1926 to help train your employees on the proper procedures for addressing traffic control. Participants must pass a competency test that includes an understanding of the flagging procedures and proper use of required equipment. The class is a combination of classroom activities, hands-on training and a skills test.
