Our Management Plan includes:

- Defining the concentrations of and changes in potential employee exposures.
- Prioritizing and controlling exposures that present unacceptable risks by methods described in A Strategy for Assessing and Managing Occupational Exposures, a publication of the American Industrial Hygiene Association.
- Documenting exposures and control efforts and communicating the results with all affected employees.
- Maintaining a historical database of potential exposures for personnel in each department and/or process.
