



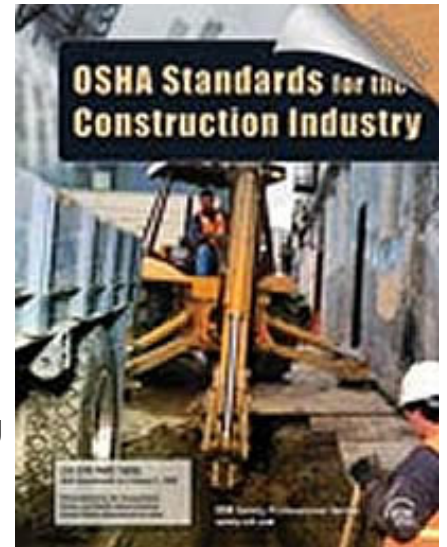

OSHA 10/30 Hour Construction Industry Course

The OSHA 10 Hour and 30 Hour Construction Industry Outreach Training course is a comprehensive safety program designed for anyone involved in the construction industry. The program has been designed to assist safety directors, foremen, and job superintendents with a better understanding of OSHA compliance issues. OSHA recommends Outreach Training Programs as an orientation to occupational safety and health for workers covered by OSHA 29 CFR 1926. Construction workers must receive additional training, when required by OSHA standards, on specific hazards of the job.

The OSHA 10 Hour and 30 Hour Construction Industry Outreach Training courses include quizzes to ensure understanding of the OSHA safety requirements and regulations. Grading of participant quizzes will take place immediately following the quiz. Remediation will be offered to those that do not pass. Upon successful completion of the OSHA 10 Hour and 30 Hour Construction Industry training programs, participants will receive an OSHA 10 Hour or 30 Hour Construction Industry Training course completion card within 4-6 weeks.

Topics include an introduction to OSHA, electrical, fall protection, scaffolding, materials handling, cranes and derricks, tools-hand and power, stairways and ladders, excavations, and personal protective equipment.
